FIM SuperEnduro World Championship & FIM Junior SuperEnduro World Cup 2022 provisional calendar, UPDATE 19 November

German rounds rescheduled in March

Due to the uncertainties and new restrictions in Germany related to the ongoing Coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic the FIM, the championship promoter ABC Communication, the German Motorcycling Federation and the local promoter have to announce the postponement of the two rounds initially scheduled to take place at the Sachsen Arena in Riesa, Germany on 8 / 9 January. The events will now take place on 19 / 20 March.
